Sealed Bids for the construction of the CDBG MIT Wastewater Pump Station Improvements project will be received by the City of Lake Butler, Florida at the office of the City Manager, 200 SW 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Lake Butler, Florida 32054, until April 16, 2026 at 2:00 p.m. local time. At that time, the Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Project includes the following Work: Construction or replacement of approximately 1,100 LF of gravity sewer in sizes 8" and 15" diameter; construction of approximately 1,800 LF of wastewater force main pipe in sizes 4" through 10" diameter; rehabilitation of six duplex wastewater pump stations; replacement of one triplex wastewater pump station; along with all related valves, fittings, sewer services, restoration work, and other associated work.
