The Project includes the following Work: A) Rehabilitation of the City's existing restricted-access effluent sprayfield, including but not limited to: regrading, regrassing, sprinkler head replacements, valve replacements, monitoring wells adjustments, and miscellaneous work; B) Replacement of wellhead piping and valves at existing Wells 1 & 2 with control improvements to Well 1.
